MINUTES – Approval of May 17, 2012 minutes - Motioned by Ms. Donnell to accept as written, seconded by Ms. Gallagher - Unanimous Vote. Approval of June 7, 2012 minutes - Motioned by Mr. Smith to accept as written, seconded by Mr. Maloney (Alternate) – Unanimous Vote.

NEW BUSINESS – Mr. Cashin wanted to schedule a workshop on procedures after the events at the June 7th meeting.
