NEW Business

 Jonathan Kenyon: 1505 Foxes Ridge Road; 260-005 Application for Conditional Use for an Auto Repair Shop.

The Auto repair shop will operate out of a 32'x24' garage already constructed on the property. Mr. Kenyon is proposing to have a parking lot that can hold up to 10 cars at a time, but not planning to have anymore then at one time. Mr. Kenyon will be the sole owner and operator of the Auto shop. The proposed hours of business will be 7 am to 9 pm. Mr. Kenyon stated that he is normally done for the day by 5 pm. The vegetive buffers around his property are approximately 100' to 350' in width.

The Planning Boards concerns for the applicant were, how were the oil and fluids from the car to be disposed of? Mr. Kenyon stated the oil will go into 55-gallon drums and will be picked up by clean harbor. Tools on site are mostly cordless. Mike Demers offered to have a sound reading to know the level of sounds that Mr. Kenyon will be working with.

The Planning Board set a date with Mr. Kenyon for a site walk for May 19th at 5 pm on the property location at 1505 Foxes Ridge Road.
