

**TOWN OF ACTON
SELECTMEN'S MEETING
JUNE 19, 2007**

1. PUBLIC FORUM: Dennis noted that Peacock Road was on the Town Meeting Warrant even though it did not meet all the Class B standards. Jim had said beforehand, that he would be checking with MMA as to the legality of having that article on the warrant. Nancy said that the only legal issue that MMA had mentioned was that all easement deeds be received in adequate time before the Town Meeting, which was done.. This was the first road to come before the Town meeting since the Road Ordinance was enacted. It is a learning process for all concerned. Issues will come up and the selectmen will work through them. Bob Anderson reported he went on Peacock Road today and was impressed with what a good road it is.

It was so voted.

(B) **PROPOSALS FOR TOWN HALL FLOOR:** Scott Gregoire's proposal for \$12,100 to replace the Town Hall floor being the lowest, on a motion by Jim, the proposal was accepted.

(C) **PROPOSALS FOR NEW TELEPHONE SYSTEM:** On a motion by Jim it was voted to accept Coastal Telephone's proposal for \$5991.96. Proposals are on file with the Town Clerk.
