A site review plan is called for in the Comp Plan and is needed. This will give the Planning Board a much broader scope of review than the present, conditional use plan allows. CEO Ken Paul noted that this pro-active approach should have happened years ago. It will also encompass commercial, multi-family units. A special Town Meeting will need to be called to vote on this.
