Nancy said they have not discussed this but will take it under consideration.

Virginia also asked if the selectmen know yet who will be plowing. Nancy said she thought it would be the Road Commissioner.

Several from the group expressed their concerns about the timber harvest operation on Covewood and the possible degradation to water quality. CEO Ken Paul was called into the meeting and reported he called the DEP two weeks ago but has not heard from them. Ken will do a site walk tomorrow and get someone from the DEP to come out.

It was also noted that a culvert on Covewood has been damaged. Nancy will have the Road Commissioner look at this.
