- (1) **AUDIT**: Ron Smith, the School Committee with Superintendent Hadley and the Warrant and Finance Committee were present. Ron noted the Town is in good condition financially. Our undesignated fund balance is \$768,027, which is a 45 day reserve. He said the ideal fund balance would be \$100,000 He recommended the Town monitor spending and revenues at the present time. Ron commended the Acton School Committee for controlling spending and managing their budget during this period of revenue curtailment. Larissa invited questions from the boards and the audience, but there were very few questions.
