1. PUBLIC FORUM: Asst. Fire Chief Petey Smith was present to discuss the meeting held last week in Waterboro relative to dispatch. Petey reported there were many unanswered questions and no answers that were favorable to Acton. The Gray group reported they have grants to upgrade equipment and are forming committees to meet with them but it may take two years before any major changes take place. Response time for dispatching is still the biggest issue for Acton. Too much valuable time is elapsing before our units are toned out. Petey gave the selectmen informational handouts. Percy Lowell and Chip Venell both noted that the selectmen should contact the governor and the newspapers. Bob Anderson suggested that payment be withheld for lack of service.

Tom Cashin asked selectmen to consider abandoning or discontinuing the Old North Shapleigh Road before development occurs. Selectmen agreed to look into the matter. Possible they will ask the Road Committee to advise.
